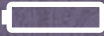
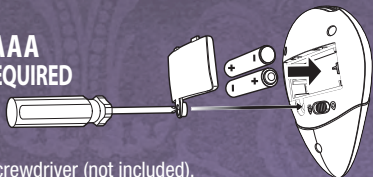


Battery Information

ALKALINE BATTERIES REQUIRED
NOT INCLUDED

TO INSERT BATTERIES

Use a Phillips/crosshead screwdriver (not included).



ADULT
4+ PLAYERS

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

Batteries should be replaced by an adult.



CAUTION:

1. As with all small batteries, these batteries should be kept away from children. If swallowed, seek medical attention immediately.
2. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.
3. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries, or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
4. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
5. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
6. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
7. Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
8. **RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:** Do not mix these with any other types of batteries. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. **DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.**

AIM!

Get your team to say the Guess word at the top of the card.
But don't use any of the Taboo words in your description . . . that'll get you buzzed by the other team!

GUESS WORD

The word you want your team to say.



TABOO WORDS

The words you can't say.

EXAMPLE:

"SLURPING A BIT OF TEQUILA OUT OF SOMEONE'S MIDSECTION . . ."

SET IT UP!

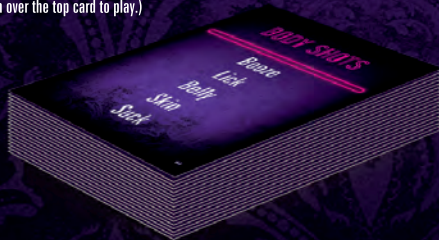
SPLIT INTO 2 TEAMS

Sit like this so you can keep an eye on each other.



SORT YOUR CARDS

- Choose which side of the cards to play this game. (Use the other side next time to keep the Guess words fresh.)
- Check that all cards are the same way up.
- Put the stack on the table with your chosen side facing down. (You will turn over the top card to play.)



PLAY!

One team guesses while the other team turns the timer and holds the buzzer.

WHEN IT'S YOUR TEAM'S TURN TO GUESS

- Choose one player on your team to be the describer. Give them the stack of cards.
- The other team chooses a monitor to hold the buzzer and start the timer.
 - The monitor peers over the describer's shoulder to see the card – if the describer uses any Taboo words, the monitor buzzes 'em!
- When the timer starts, your team's describer immediately:
 - turns over the top card
 - describes the top word on the side you've chosen to play without saying any of the Taboo words!
 - puts any cards that get buzzed to one side
 - keeps turning over cards and describing new words for your team to guess.
- When the timer runs out, your team's turn is over. Put the card that was in play at the bottom of the deck.
 - Score 1 point for each card you guessed successfully.
 - Give 1 point to the other team for each card that you got buzzed on or skipped.
- It's now the other team's turn.



WHEN TO BUZZ!

BUZZ WHEN THE DESCRIBER BREAKS ANY OF THESE RULES!

- Don't say any part of any word on the card! (E.g. you can't say 'loop' or 'hole' if the word is 'loophole'.)
- Don't use sneaky plurals! (E.g. you can't say 'feet' for 'foot' if it's 'foot fetish'.) Don't gesture or act!
- Don't make noises or use sound effects!
- Don't say 'sounds like' – that's too easy!
- Don't use abbreviations! (E.g. you can't say 'TV' for 'television'.)

HOW TO WIN!

When all players have taken the same number of turns as the describer, the team with the most points wins all the glory!

IF THERE'S A TIE, JUST KEEP PLAYING . . .
YOU KNOW YOU WANT TO!
