





THE FIRST TIME YOU PLAY

- 1. Punch out the two tray pieces from the parts sheet.
- 2. Fold the larger piece and insert it into the opening in the game box. This acts as a tray for your game pieces.
- 3. Fold the smaller piece and insert it in the card box, to lean the cards against.





TL;DR

Roll, move, answer 2010s trivia. Be the first to collect a wedge of each color, then answer a final question correctly to win.

GET READY

- 1. Decide whether to play individually or in teams.
- 2. Each player or team picks an empty wedge holder and places it on the center space.
- 3. The player with the best 2010s dance moves goes first.

THE CATEGORIES

- **Playlist:** The biggest songs, artists, and music moments of the 2010s.
- **Bingeworthy:** All the movies and shows we couldn't stop watching.
- **News Alert:** A decade's worth of buzzworthy events.
- **#Culture:** Trends in food, fashion, art, pop culture, and more.
- **Break the Internet:** The best (and weirdest) of the web.
- Game On: Highlights in sports, video games, and other competitions.

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PLAT

ROLL

ON YOUR TURN

1. Roll the die and move that many spaces.

- On your first turn, you choose which path to go down.
- You can move in any direction, switching it up every turn. You just can't reverse within the same move.
- The center space counts as one. You can move straight across it or turn to go down another path.

2. Which space did you land on?

ROLL AGAIN

Roll again and move! You can reverse the direction you had been going. Continue your turn wherever you land.

CATEGORY

It's trivia time! The player to your left (or on another team) draws a card from the front of the deck and reads aloud the question matching the color you're on.

Got it right? Yaas, roll again and keep playing!

Not the answer? Sad. Your turn is over.

BTW if you're playing as a team, you can discuss before answering.



CENTER

Wild! You choose the category. The player to your left (or on another team) draws a card from the front of the deck and reads aloud that question.

Got it right? Roll again and continue your turn because YOLO.

Not the answer? Welp, turn over.



WEDGE

Let's get that wedge! The player to your left (or on another team) draws a card from the front of the deck and reads aloud the question matching the color you're on.

Got it right? Add that color wedge to your holder. That completes your turn.

Not the answer? Your turn is over. You can't stay on this space for your next turn, though you can come back later.

You can only earn one wedge per category. Those are the rules. Don't @ us.

- 3. Put used cards in the back of the deck.
- **4. That's it. That's your turn.** Now the player to your left (or the next team) goes. Keep playing until one player or team has collected a wedge of each color. (See #Winning.)

FYI

- You must move the *exact* number you rolled. Sorry, not sorry.
- Once you've earned a wedge in a certain color, you can't get another one, but you can keep answering questions in that category. If you get a question right but already have that wedge, you get to roll again.
- Any number of wedge holders can be on the same space.
- You can only get a wedge from Wedge spaces. (It's in the name!)

#WINNING

- Once your wedge holder is filled with six wedges of different colors, **immediately** move it to the center space.
- 2. On your next turn, the other players (or teams) choose the category of your final question. Then they draw a card and read that question.

Got it right? You win! Maybe do a celebratory dab or whatever else you thought was cool in 2016?

Not the answer? As the kids say, just take the L. Stay on the center space and try again on your next turn. Your opponents can pick the category they chose before or a different one.

PLAY ON THE GO

Can't let go of the decade? Good thing this game's portable play with just the cards! Take turns answering questions, and the first player (or team) to get one right from each category wins.



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
